The most recent versions of CHILI are supported. CHILI updates have never broken the API support, new versions of CHILI are expected to be supported out of the box.

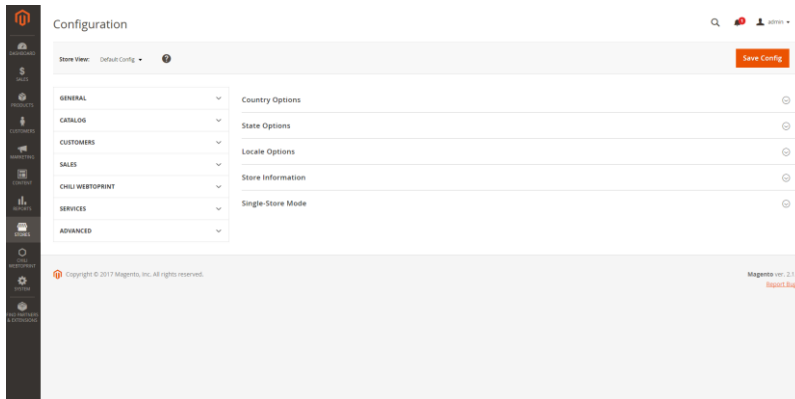
Should new versions of CHILI break functionality, a patch will be provided ASAP and support for that new version will be added in a next minor release of the CHILI Publisher Connector for Magento 2.

When you add the CHILI package to your Magento 2 setup, a CHILI WebToPrint tab will be added to the configuration.

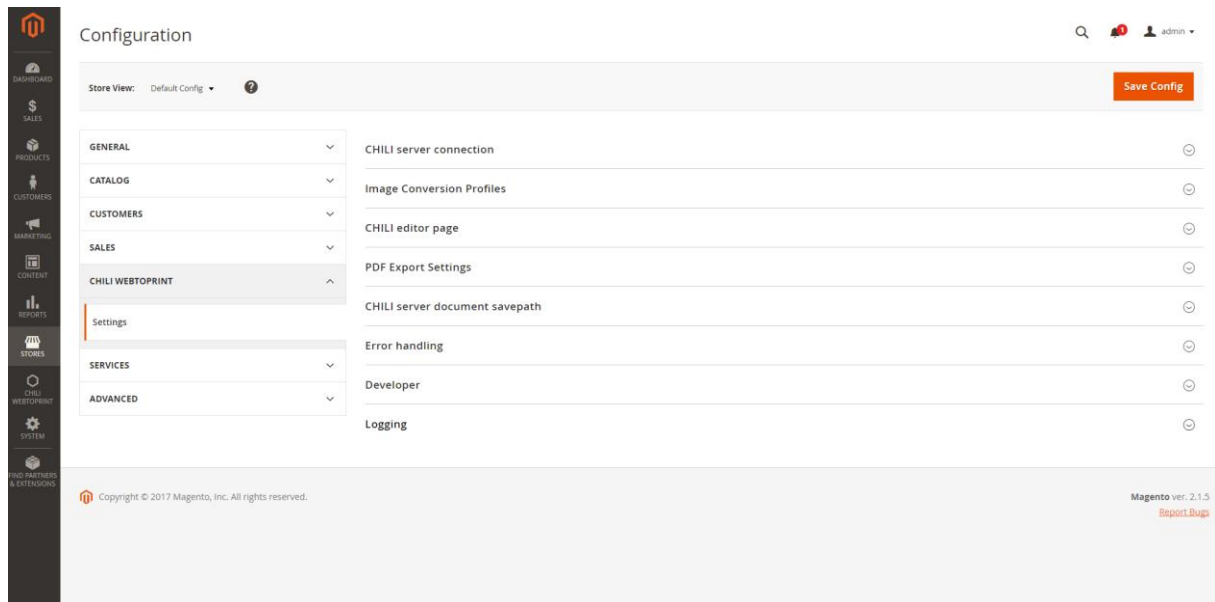

4.1.1 CHILI server connection

In the CHILI server connection section, you can configure the following:

- CHILI server URL
This URL will be used for connecting to the CHILI server
- Environment name
The CHILI environment name that will be used
- Username
The username to connect with the defined CHILI environment
- Password
The password to connect with the defined CHILI environment

Beware when you configure multiple websites with different CHILI environments! If you do so, make sure you uncheck the 'use default' checkbox for every CHILI setting. Otherwise the add to cart functionality will not work because the CHILI product refers to a CHILI environment name that is configured for another website.

4.1.3 CHILI editor page

In the CHILI editor page section, you can configure the following:

The CHILI view preferences used if no view preferences are configured on product level
- **Default document constraints**
The CHILI document constraints used if no document constraints are configured on product level
- **Header height**
The height of the header on the editor page in pixels. This is to insure the fullpage height is used without any scrollbars

- **Enable administrator workspace**
If enabled you will be allowed to manage the workspace in the CHILI editor. It is advised to disable this in a live environment
- **Enable customer concepts**
If enabled the customer can save CHILI products as concepts in the CHILI editor and look up the concepts in his account space
- **Enable confirmation before adding to cart**
If enabled the customer has to confirm his CHILI document before he can add it to his shopping cart
- **Enable field validation**
If enabled all mandatory variables on the HTML forms in the CHILI document will be validated when a customer adds a CHILI product to his cart
- **HTML form cache lifetime**
Number of seconds the auto-generated HTML form should be stored in the cache

A workspace, view preference, document constraints, PDF export settings and editor mode which need to be used for a certain document can be defined on multiple levels. This should simplify and minimize the workflow required to add new product with specific workspaces, view preferences, At first, the mechanism will try to find any workspace, view preference or document constraint configuration on the product level. In the case that no specific configuration was found on the product level, the mechanism will search the system configuration recursively for any specific configuration (which can be configured on global/website or store view scope).

The CHILI PDF export settings used for the PDF file that will be made available to the customer. The settings can be overruled on product level
- Preview PDF save path

CHILI products should only be assigned to 1 website to make sure the feature 'different environment name per website' works as intended. When you switch the CHILI product to another website, first save it and then edit the CHILI settings on the product, so that it does not have any reference anymore to the CHILI environment name of the other website.

In release 1.1.3 we added a fix for the bug that the weight product attribute is not shown for a CHILI product.

In release 1.1.4 we added a fix for the bug that the tax product attribute is not shown for a CHILI product.

4.2.2 CHILIWebToPrint

4.5 CHILI WebToPrint - PDF export grid

When you add the CHILI package to your Magento 2 setup, a button CHILI WebToPrint is added to the main navigation. When clicking this button and then 'PDF export', a PDF export grid will be shown.

In this PDF export grid, information is shown concerning the order and the CHILI preferences used for the CHILI documents in this order. The following columns are shown:

- ID
This is the CHILI request ID of the PDF document
- Status
This is the status of the order
- Path
This is the path of the PDF document on the Magento server
- Order ID
This is the ID of the order
- Order Item ID
This is the ID of the item in the order
- Export settings
This is the export profile of the CHILI server
- Type
This is the type of PDF document (Preview = frontend / Print = backend)
- Document ID
This is the ID of the document
- Task ID
This is the ID of the task
- Message
This is the message that is sent along with the order
- Updated at
This is the date on which the request is updated

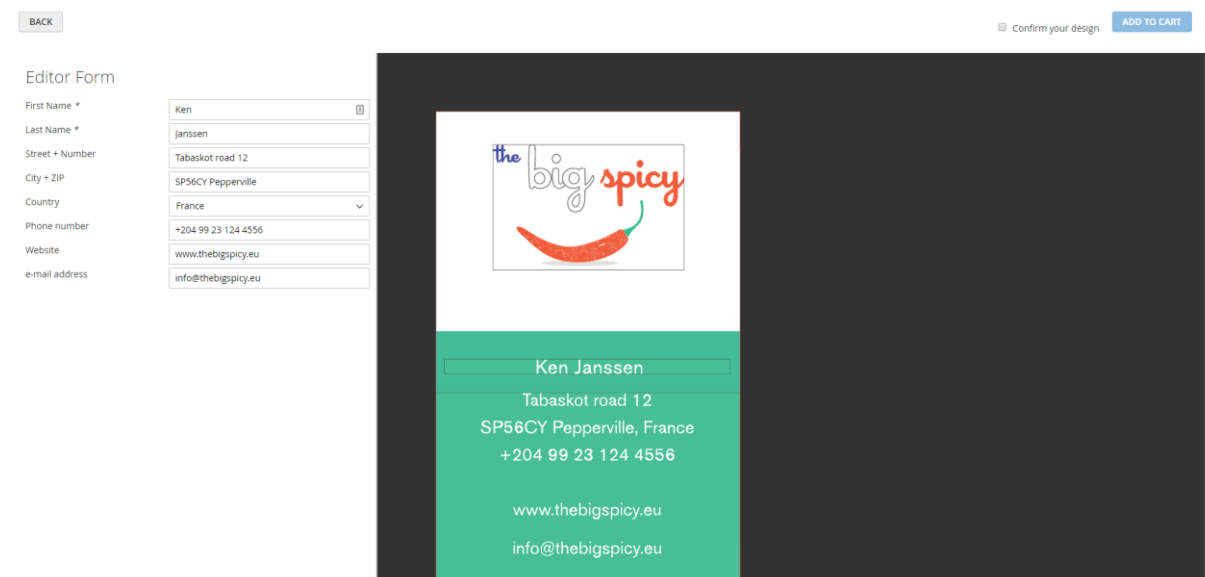

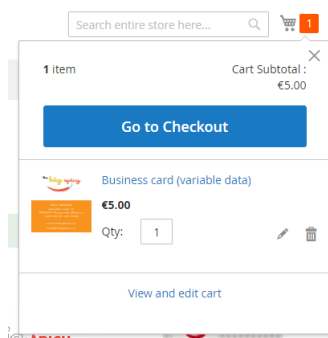

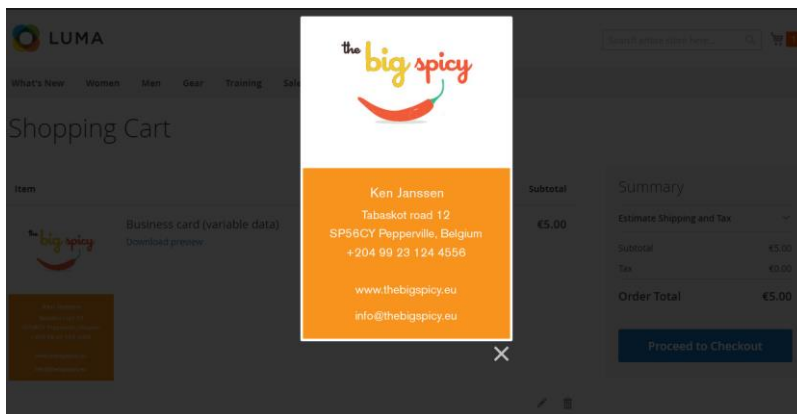
